

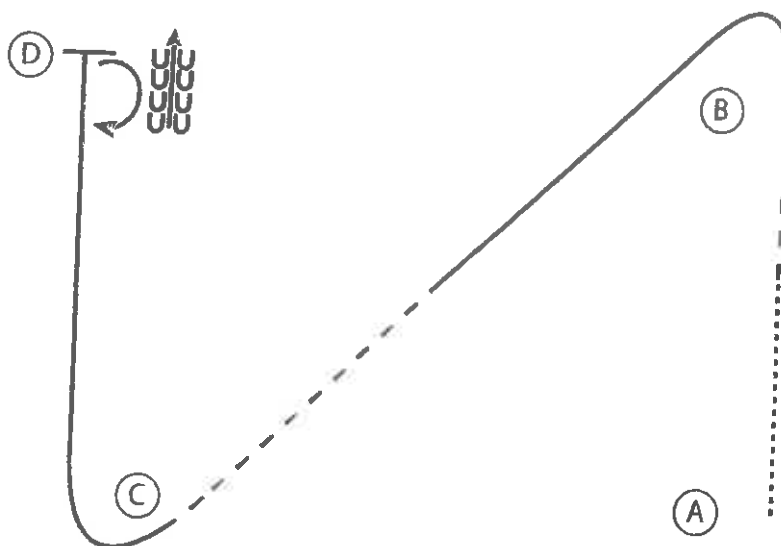

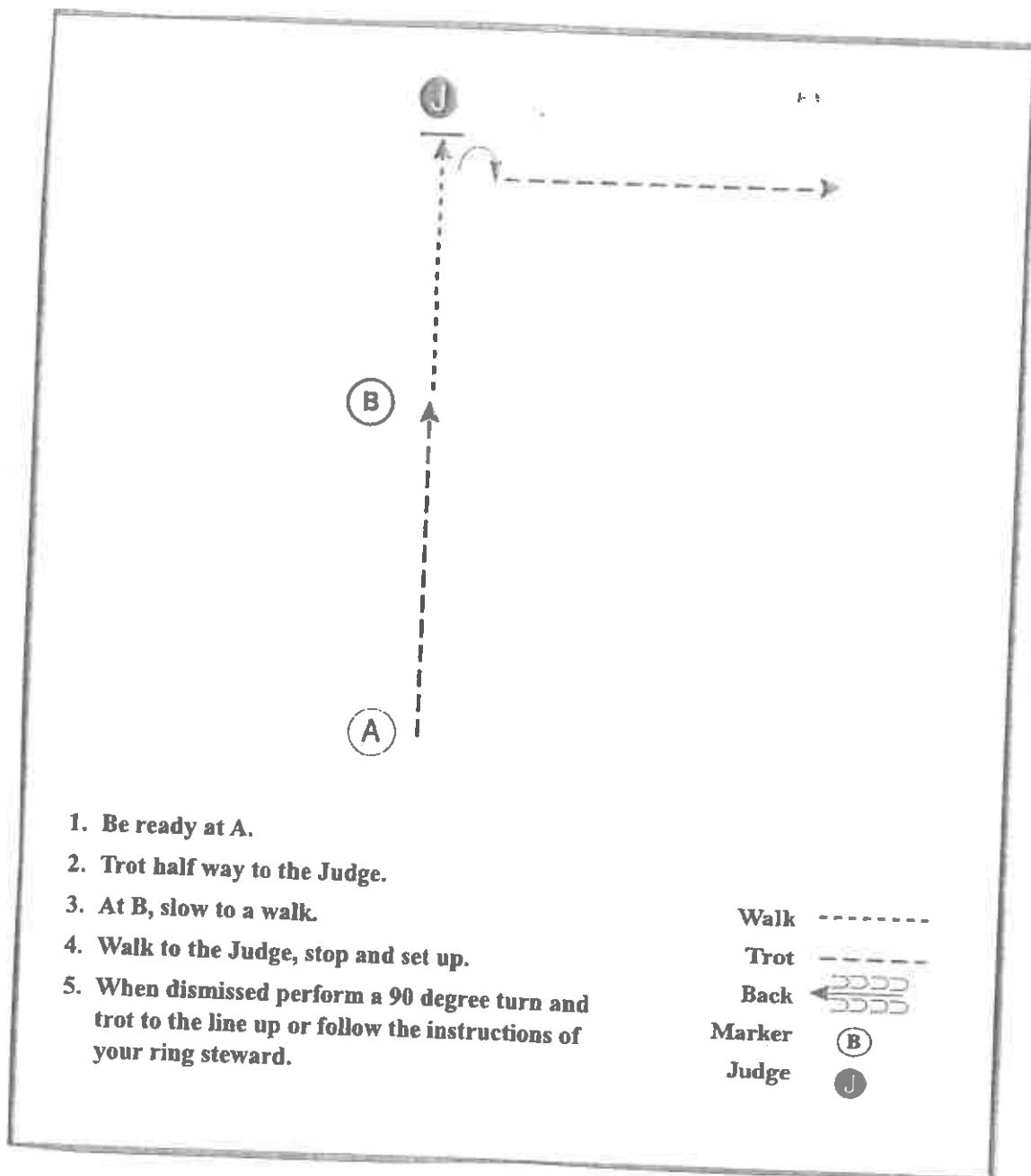

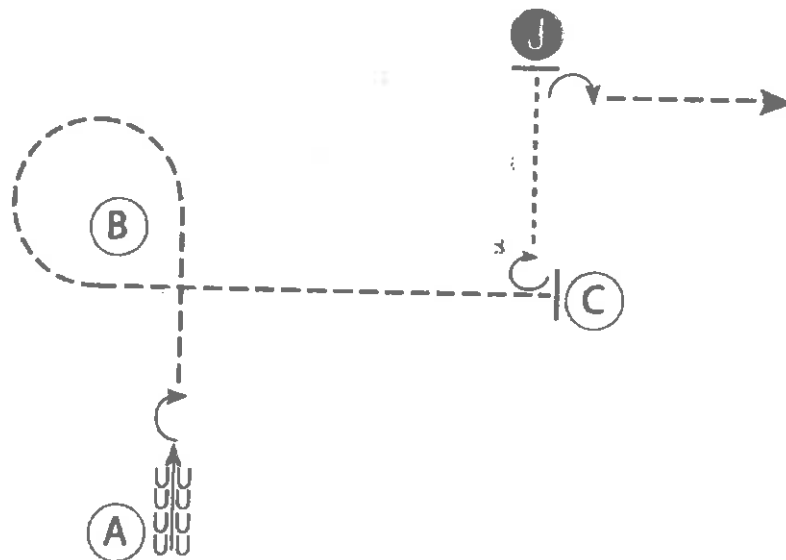

Be ready at A.

1. When acknowledged, back 5 steps.
2. Pivot 180 degrees.
3. Trot to and around B and continue to C.
4. Stop at C and turn 270 degrees.
5. Walk to judge. Stop and set up for inspection.
6. When dismissed, turn 90 degrees and trot away.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.
