

SHS and Royalty Rules

*4-H rules apply

* You must use a horse for Royalty that is listed on your project sheet. Only one exhibitor per horse.

* Horses used to try out for the SHS must be the primary horses you are taking to the fair.

*State try outs are for members 13-19 years old. They must present a **COPY** of a current Coggins when signing up for the state classes.

*If trying out for the SHS **you must** walk/Trot/Canter and **you must** participate in Walk/Trot/Canter classes at the fair.

* 4-H members trying out for royalty must be in show attire for all parts of the competition [test, interview, events and crowning.]

*Equitation Duke and Duchess will only show at a walk/trot for Horsemanship.

*In Royalty classes older members that only walk/trot may compete, but points will be lost in riding class when competing against members that lope.

*All Royalty and their courts are encouraged to help organize and put on the fun day on the last Saturday of the fair.
